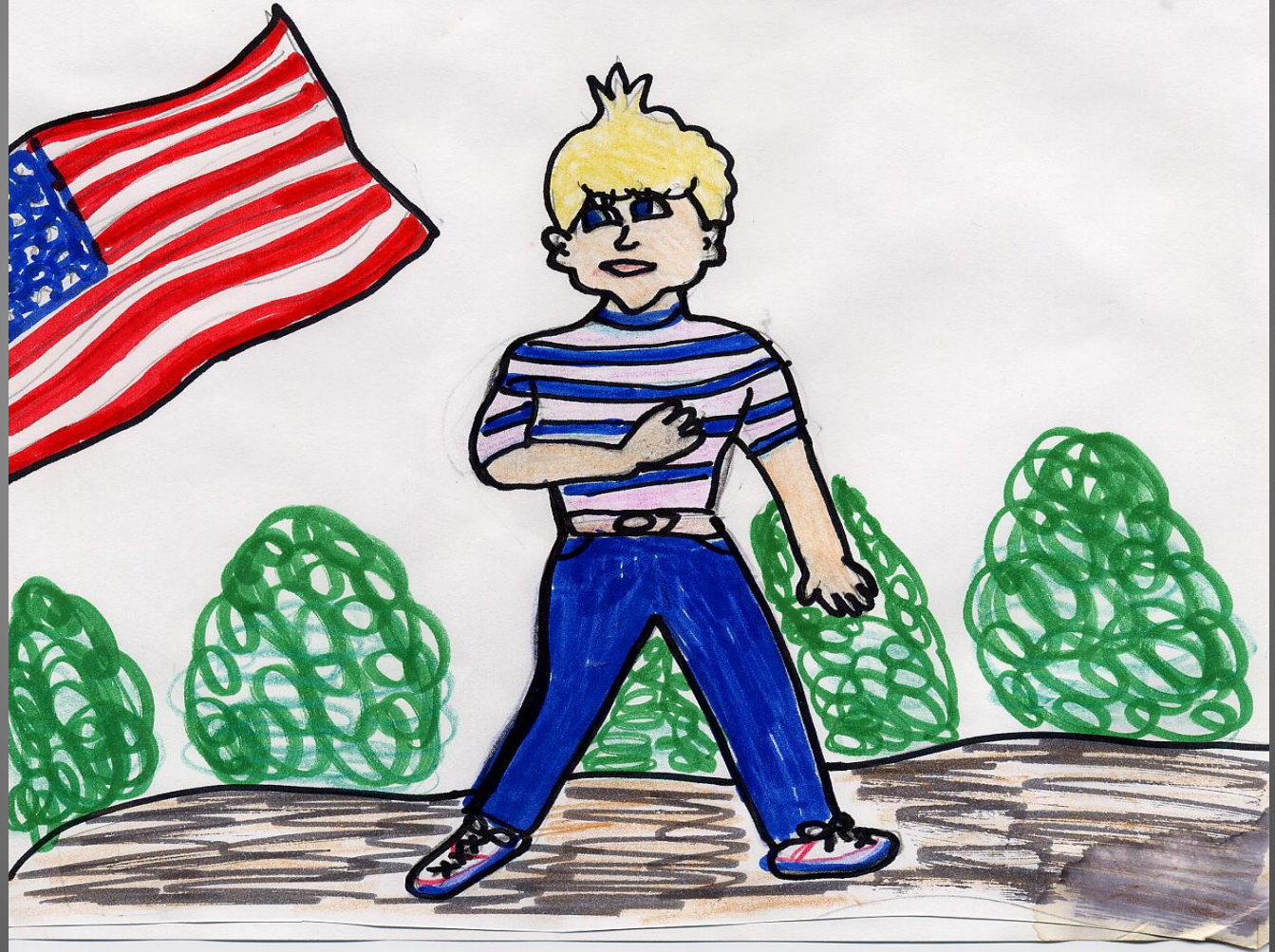

I know that I should, but I don't know why.**





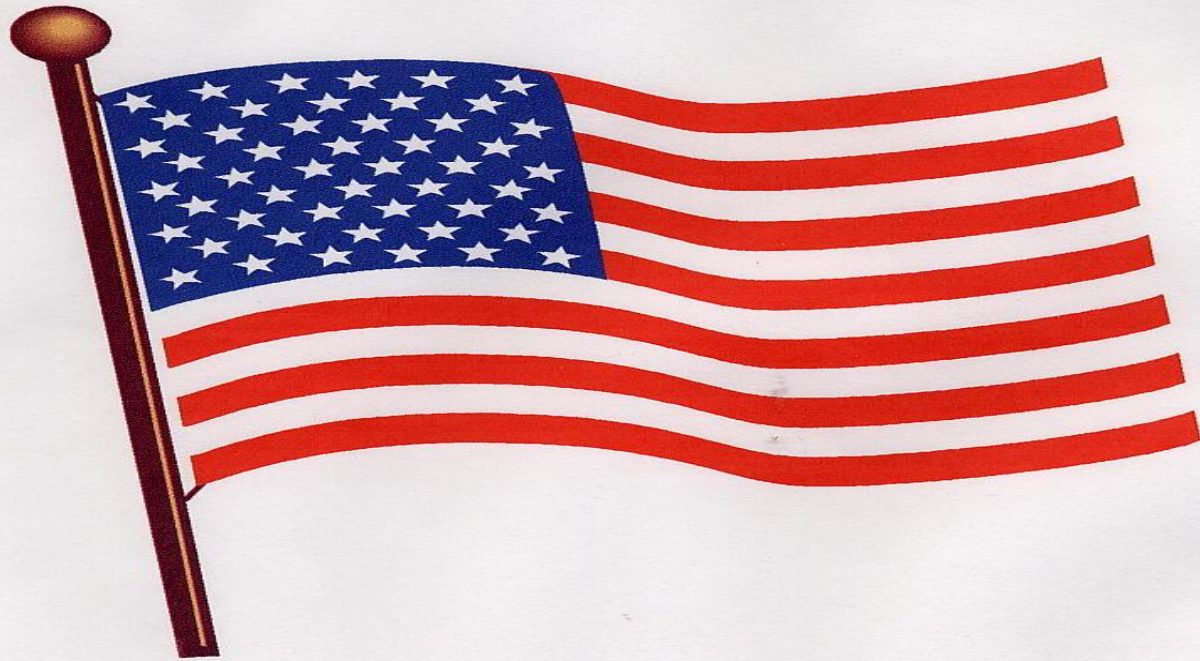
# **I PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG**

Red white and blue**



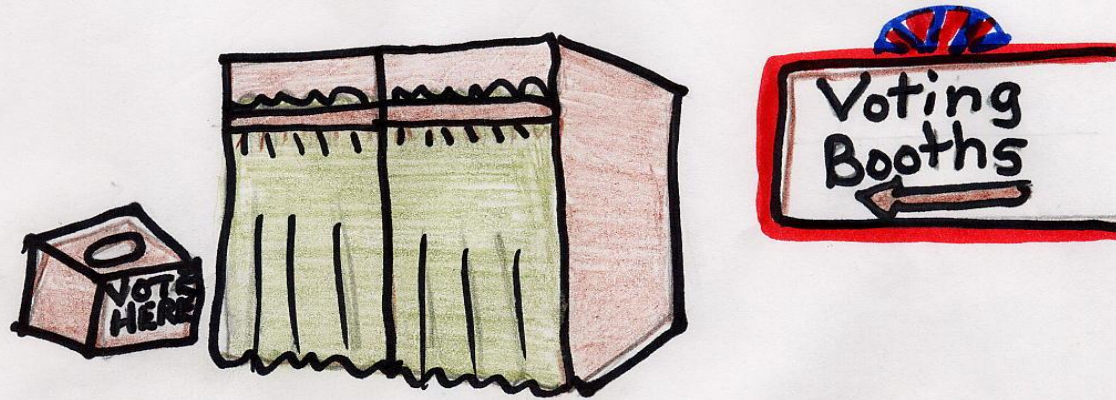
# AND TO THE REPUBLIC\*

Our lessons at school.**



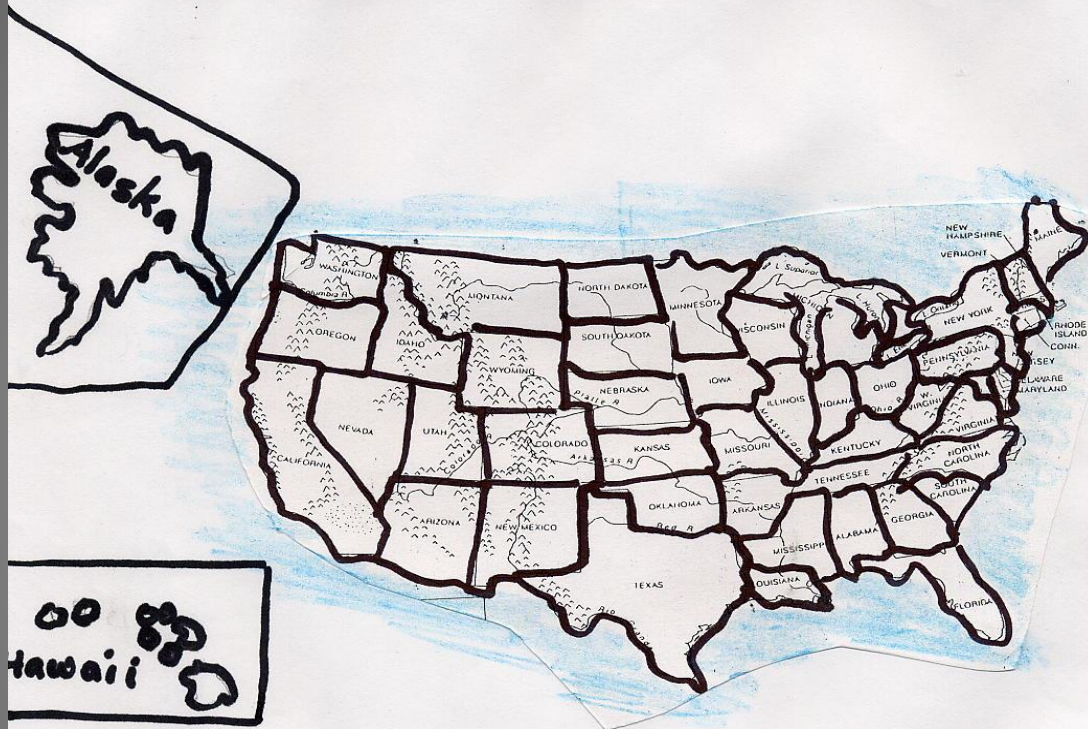
# FOR WHICH IT STANDS.

That makes us great!**



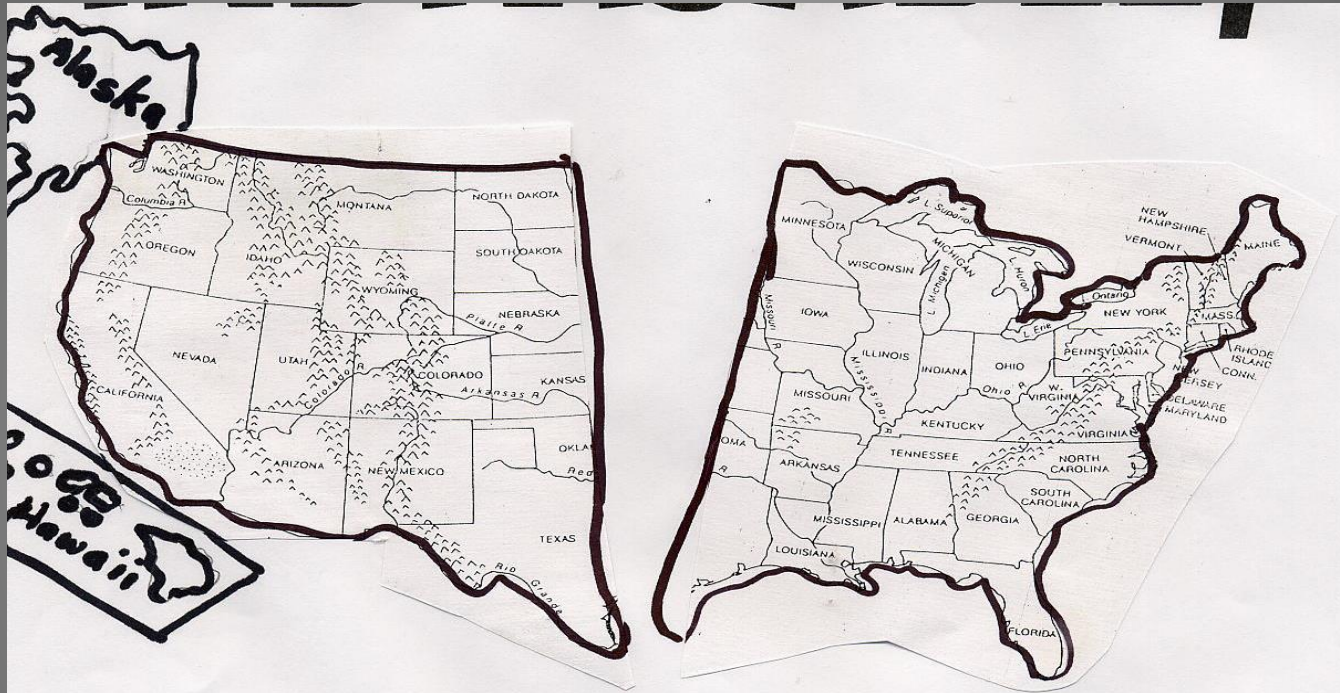
# **UNDER GOD,**

We should be grateful every day.**



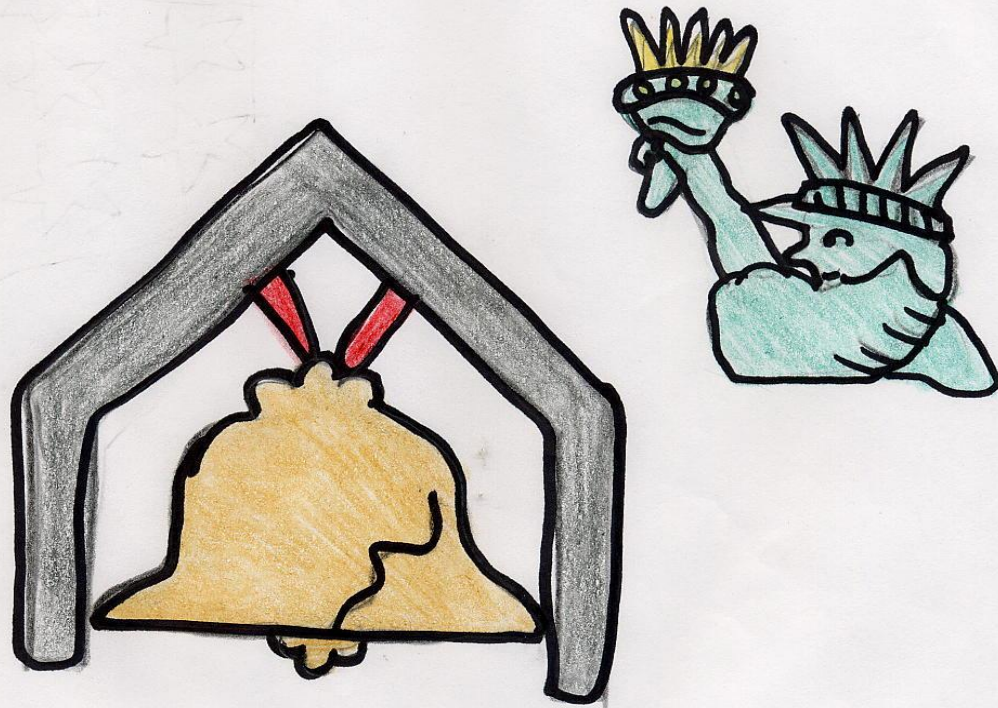
# Indivisible
