We would like to send you a warm welcome to Academic Writing with Specialized Theory and Method (711G62) or Linguistic and Literary Theory and Method (711G63)!

Given the present situation with Covid-19, most of our courses, including this one, will start in distance mode. At best we will be offering a mixture of campus and distance teaching in the second half of the spring term, although the exact nature of this mix is unclear at present. On the bright side, we now have established routines for all our courses to run them smoothly in distance mode.

The introduction to the course is currently planned to take place on **Mon, 8 February at 13.15-14** via the Zoom app.

You will need to have set up your own account in Zoom beforehand in order to access the meeting. You will also need to enter the password after clicking on the meeting link in the box below. Besides an internet connection, you will need a microphone and video camera (often inbuilt in modern laptops).
