For admission to the course the students shall have documented knowledge of English equivalent to "Engelska B", or an international proficiency test, e.g. TOEFL, minimum score 550/213, and at least one year of full-time undergraduate studies.

The course is internet-based. Teaching consists of set of questions that the student shall answer individually and/or collectively. The language of the course is English.
