For admission to the course, the specific entry requirements that apply for admission to the Bachelor's Programme in Cognitive Science must be satisfied, and the courses Linguistics, Computers in Linguistics, or the equivalent, must be completed.

Intended learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the student should be able to

- transcribe and analyse oral communication
- discuss and critically analyse the relationship between language and communication.

Course content

The contents of the course are focused on:

- introduction to the subject of oral communication
- interactive sentence building in oral communication
- conversation analysis
- non-verbal signals in oral communication
- Language and social relations.

Teaching and working methods

The course is given as seminars that require active student participation. The student's participation requires studies of literature, preparation before discussions in collaboration with other course participants and written presentation of the seminar discussions.

The course is examined through a written examination and active participation in seminars.
